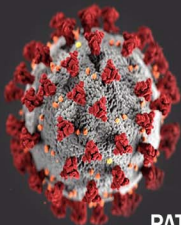


COVID-19:

- ➔ TODAY IS THE 1ST DAY THAT ARKANSAS RESTAURANTS CAN DO DINE-IN SERVICE AT 33% CAPACITY.
- ➔ ARKANSAS HAS \$78 MILLION IN RESERVE FUNDS FOR UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION.
- ➔ THE ARKANSAS READY FOR BUSINESS GRANT PROGRAM HAS HAD OVER 12,000 BUSINESSES APPLY FOR THE \$147 MILLION IN AVAILABLE FUNDING.
- ➔ THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH REPORTS THAT 69,008 ARKANSANS HAVE BEEN TESTED TO DATE, EXCEEDING THE GOVERNOR'S GOAL OF HAVING 60,000 ARKANSANS TESTED BY THE END OF MAY.
