



On Thursday, the<u>House passed HB1023</u>. This bill states that all US flags and Arkansas flags of purchased by a public entity with public funds shall be made and manufactured in the United States.

The <u>House passed HB1024</u>. This bill removes the requirement for cities seeking to create an entertainment district to collect a tax on restaurant and hotel purchases.

The <u>House also passed HB1028</u>. This bill replaces the term "child pornography" with the term "child sexual abuse material" in Arkansas code.
