DAILY SUMMARY FOR TUESDAY, JANUARY 31, 2023

On Tuesday, the [House Judiciary Committee](#) advanced [HB1004](#). This bill amends the [Sex Offender Registration Act](#) by requiring the physical address of the sex offender, including the house or apartment number, to be made public. Currently, only the street name and block number are required.

The [House Education Committee](#) advanced [HB1156](#). This bill states that public schools and open-enrollment public charter schools shall designate multiple occupancy restrooms for exclusive use by the male sex or exclusive use by the female sex.

The full House passed [HB1082](#). This bill establishes the [Occupational Therapy Licensure Compact in Arkansas](#).

The House also passed [HB1026](#). This bill prohibits local governments from enacting an income tax.
